



Execute Chrome with command line arguments - 7.6.0R110 or later

Description

From Robot / NTBR v7.6.0R110 and on, it is possible to execute Chrome with arguments using SetOption() function in a RIA environment scenario.

Syntax

Bool SetOption(**Option** as String, **ParamStr** as String, **ParamInt** as Int)

Parameter(s)

Option - "CHROME_STARTUP_ARGS"

ParamStr - Chrome command line arguments (cf. example)

ParamInt - 0 (default value)

Return value

TRUE if option is correctly set, otherwise FALSE

Example(s)

Start Chrome maximized, regardless of any previous settings:

reference to undefined name 'syntax' Une exception de type 'MindTouch.Deki.Script.Runtime.DekiScriptUndefinedNameException' a été levée.

Start Chrome maximized and activate #Allow-insecure-localhost flag:
